Program Description

The Mathematics Teacher Leadership Program is a two year, graduate-level program designed to develop and support teacher leadership skills. The purpose of the program is to establish professional learning communities that focus on improving the teaching and learning of K-12 mathematics through the development of teacher leaders. Candidates for the program are experienced administrators and teachers with strong mathematics content and pedagogical knowledge.

The Teacher Leadership program is a joint offering by the University of Northern Colorado and the University of Wyoming and is funded under Grant No. 0832026 from the National Science Foundation.
