► Program Description

This two-year program is intended for current secondary math teachers who want to deepen and extend their mathematics knowledge and want to learn more about curriculum, instruction, and assessment. Coursework is both face-to-face and online. The program offers a collaborative learning environment in which participants engage in rigorous mathematics, explore pedagogical content knowledge, and learn to connect research and practice.
